To comply with County of Mendocino Health Orders & SPACE Protocols

- All classes will be groups of 10 students or less plus one teacher & one assistant for 4 weeks
- All staff and students will wear face coverings while on campus and maintain social distancing
- Proper sanitation for any shared equipment/spaces
- Mandatory temperature readings for all staff and students at check-in
- In case of smoke, rain, exposure to Covid-19 by any participant, or new Public Health requirements, classes will transition to Zoom.
- Co-Director will be onsite at each class to ensure that all safety protocols are followed.
- Parents/Guardians are required to sign Covid-19 Safety agreement. If at any point the student does not follow safety protocols, they will not be eligible for these courtyard classes.
- Students can only register for one class per each 4-week session.

From Teacher Jim (Beatty) - Creative Dance 1, 2 & 3

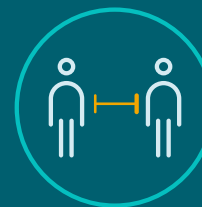

- Todas las clases serán grupos de 10 estudiantes o menos más un instructor y un asistente durante 4 semanas
- Todo el personal y los estudiantes usarán una mascarilla mientras están en SPACE y mantendrán el distanciamiento social
